The course first takes learners through a guided exploration of current issues in ELT materials development to provide the foundation for their future material development choices. Students then practice evaluating various ELT materials before applying what they have learned by creating their own materials, putting them into practice, and revising them based on their own self-evaluation as well as peer and instructor feedback.</p>
